



Mayer Fire District

The Mayer Fire Department is a combination fire/medical district that provides fire suppression, fire prevention, wildland protection, advanced life support, rescue, extrication, and medical transportation services out of 3 stations to approximately 10,000 residents in a 52 square mile district. In addition, the Mayer Fire Department also covers an additional 250 square miles outside of the district. This includes being first due to areas of the Prescott National Forest, BLM Lands, State Lands, and the Agua Fria National Monument.

The Mayer Fire Department also covers over 25 miles of I-17, the major four lane Interstate that is the main route between the Phoenix area and northern Arizona, as well as over 13 miles of State Route 69, the connector between I-17 and Prescott.

The Mayer area is located one hour north of the Phoenix metro area and 30 minutes east of Prescott. At an elevation of 4,500 ft., we experience all seasons which is perfect for outdoor activities with surrounding public access.

Reserve Firefighter

Overview:

We have immediate openings for ALS and BLS reserve firefighters. We will also be creating a hiring list that will remain in place for the next twelve months.

The Reserve Firefighter EMT/CEP performs a variety of duties. The salary range for the position is \$11.00 for EMT and \$13.26 for CEP. Continued employment as a "Qualified Reserve" is dependent upon successful completion of the reserve training program. This is a part-time position with benefits that include potential for out of district wildland fire response, uniform allowance, employee assistance, potential for full-time employment for reserves in good standing, and unique training opportunities.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 21-years of age.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Current State of Arizona or National Registry EMT/Paramedic certification.
- State of Arizona FF I&II Certification.
- Wildland S130/190 (employees that do not have this, will have 12 months from date of hire to obtain).
- Passing CPAT within the last 12 months.

Special Requirements:

- Must possess a valid Arizona driver's license.
- Must pass a DPS background check and fingerprint clearance.
- Must have good communication skills.

Employment Process:

- Interested applicants must submit a resume and completed online application at www.mayerfire.com
- Qualified candidates will be invited to take a written exam at Mayer Fire.
- Administration offices located at 11975 SR 69 Mayer, AZ 86333.
- Candidates that successfully pass the written test will be invited to an oral interview.
- Select candidates will be invited for second round oral board with the Fire Chief, and Reserve Coordinator.
- Selected candidates will be invited to a 48 hour (4-12 hour days) mandatory on site orientation (candidates that have 1 year or more of full -time employment at a similar size of larger fire department will be offered a 24 hour ride along orientation in lieu of the 48 hour on site orientation).
